Week 3: *Day Off*Our Choices Affect Others

Choose or Lose

Yikes! Our choices can really affect others. This is a funny way to drive that point home to your Loop students.

Activity Objective

Answer the trivia questions correctly to spare the group from having to do some serious challenges!

You'll Need

Choose or Lose activity supplement (1 per experience)

Instructions

- 1. Ask students to line up.
- 2. Explain: We're going to play a new kind of trivia game today to show how our choices, wrong and right, can affect others. One person will come to the front to answer a trivia question. Some of these questions will be harder than others. So, if the person gets it right, nothing happens and the next person comes to the front. But, if the person gets it wrong, everyone has to do a challenge!
- 3. Read off the questions and challenges, if necessary, from the **Choose or Lose** activity supplement.
- 4. Ask students: Is it fair that sometimes we had to do challenges when we didn't get the question wrong? (No! It's not fair. But we have to remember that sometimes things happen to us that are out of our control—things that are a direct result of someone else's choices or actions.)
- 5. Ask students: Is it fair that some of the questions were harder than others? (No! That's not fair, either. But sometimes, our choices will be harder than other times. That's why it's important to seek God's wisdom, ask trusted leaders, and pray about our choices.)
