Week 3: *What Happens Next?*
Purity

What Happens Next?

This activity is a fun way for students to think about how they would react in a scenario where they don't know what's next. It shows that we need standards now to determine how we'll act later.

Activity Objective

Make your choice on what happens next!

You'll Need

- What Happens Next? activity supplement (1 per room)*

***Note:** Make sure you keep the activity supplement in good condition and store it for the next service to use.

Instructions

Activity:

1. **Tell** students to get in the middle of the room.
2. **Explain:**
 - Just like in today's episode, we're going to go over some scenarios of "What happens next?"
 - I'll read off some scenarios, and you'll choose which answer you think should happen.
 - But you only have **10 seconds** to decide!
3. **Assign** a corner for each answer choice and **point** where you mean. (*i.e. The front left corner is A, the back left corner is B, the right front corner is C and the back right corner is D.*)
4. **Read** off each scenario from the "What happens next?" activity supplement.
5. **Give** students 10 seconds to decide their answer and get in their corner.
6. **Ask** if anyone wants to share why they chose that answer. (*Don't give right/wrong answers right now. Let students explain themselves, and they can talk about why they chose each one in their small groups later.*)
7. **Continue** the activity until you run out of scenarios.
8. **Explain:**
 - This activity reminds us that we need to prepare for scenarios where we don't know what happens next. Having standards helps us decide what we'll do before we're in a high-pressure situation.
 - Are you happy with the standards you have right now?
 - We'll spend some time talking about that in small groups. And you can let your leader know why you chose the answers the way you did. Have fun, and thanks for playing!
